CONSTRUCTION HOURS (TYPICAL):

SITE ACCESS:

Construction vehicles will use Briarwood Drive as a temporary access the site. The vehicles and equipment will remain within the construction area during the day and exit via Briarwood Drive. Staging will remain within the limits of the construction site. See staging plans above.

PROJECT DETAILS:

The Oaklands Stream Restoration Project is being completed in order to develop a new stable stream channel that can adequately and safely convey major storm events within the existing stream channel. The project plans call for developing an adequate slope around the perimeter of the stream to address the public's safety concerns. The proposed stream channel will be stabilized to prevent further erosion of sediment. This stream restoration will include the installation of several trees and shrubs which over time will provide a biological uplift along the stream.

Construction will occur in four (4) major phases starting at Briarwood Drive and concluding at the pedestrian bridge between Briarcroft Lane and Eisenhower Middle School.
