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The Clean Water Partnership (CWP) is a Public-Private Partnership (P3) between Prince George's County and Corvias. The CWP is the first of its kind to design, build, finance, operate, and maintain urban stormwater infrastructure to meet Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4) regulatory requirements and is committed to retrofit up to 4,000 impervious acres.

PROJECT DETAILS

CWP previously installed a filter diaphragm in late-2019 to address a minor leak from the upper lake to the lower lake. Maryland Department of The Environment (MDE), has requested that CWP return to add additional rip-rap (large stones) at the edge of the pond for stabilization, as well as to remove a tree stump on the pond's embankment. Both the upper and lower lake will be dewatered prior to construction.
