#### **PROJECT DETAILS:**

The Oxon Run water quality project will promote clean water and a sustainable natural habitat in the Oxon Run community. The project includes upgrading the existing County stormwater pond to improve its capacity to treat stormwater runoff before entering downstream waters. Downstream of the pond, the project includes stream and floodplain restoration, to reduce erosion and promote development of a stable stream and wetland system. This project also includes protection of existing sanitary sewers by covering and removing them from conflict with the stream.

#### **CONSTRUCTION DETAILS:**

The proposed work involves the removal of sediment and material from the pond and clearing of vegetation within the buffer area, as required by the Maryland Department of the Environment. The contractor will access and exit the construction site from Livingston Rd. to Birchwood Dr. to Galloway Drive and will maintain the road daily to ensure safe passage along the construction site.
