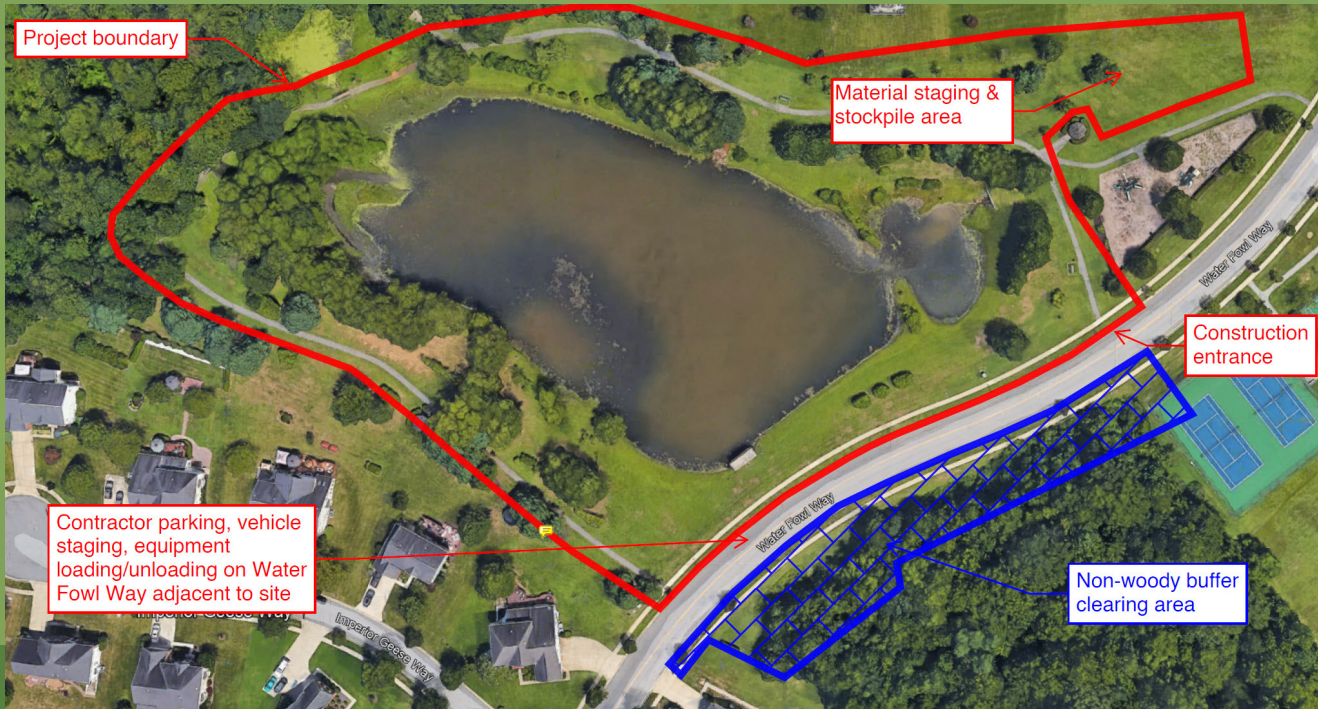


CLEAN WATER PARTNERSHIP PERRYWOOD STORMWATER RETROFIT PROJECT



CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

PROJECT ADDRESS

Waterfowl Way Pond, Upper Marlboro, MD 20774

ANTICIPATED START DATE:

February 2024 (weather permitting)

ANTICIPATED COMPLETION DATE:

November 2024 (weather Permitting)

PROJECT DETAILS:

The Perrywood stormwater management pond is an existing wet pond that will be retrofitted by the Clean Water Partnership to meet current federal regulatory stormwater compliance requirement. The project will include constructing forebays at each of the ponds inflow channels resulting in improved water quality. This stormwater construction project will also incorporate the addition of an aquatic bench and the installation of native vegetation that will help reduce pollutants and sediments entering the pond.

CONSTRUCTION DETAILS:

The proposed work involves the modification of one forebay and the construction of two new forebays, removal of sediment and material from the pond and clearing of vegetation within the non-wood buffer area along Water Fowl Way, as required by Maryland Department of the Environment. Contractor will access and exit the construction site from Water Fowl Way and will maintain the road daily to ensure safe passage along the construction site.

PROGRAM DETAILS:

The Clean Water Partnership is a 30-year community-based partnership between Prince George's County and Corvias Infrastructure Solutions (CIS) with a turnkey stormwater management program that has proven its ability to achieve regulatory compliance requirements, create greater community buy-in and education along with long-term local economic benefits for residents and local, small, and minority disadvantaged businesses. The partnership includes a 30-year maintenance agreement, making the CWP responsible for functional maintenance to ensure proper function of the facility; thereafter, the County will assume responsibility.
